CAMPAIGN REPORT SPECIAL

Blackley & Broughton

The Conservative result was just short of 5,600 votes. Unfortunately that was down on 2010 - when we came second on a massive swing. This time we came third, behind UKIP. However, our vote held up well despite the much bigger organisation UKIP now have in the constituency.

I decided to focus my efforts on the two target wards: Crumpsall (Sham Raja) and Kersal (Arnold Saunders). Together with my assistant Arian, and some local activists we made real progress. In the local government election in Kersal, we came within 238 votes of winning! Our best result in the ward in many years. We believe we took many of these votes from Labour. In Broughton Park, people were even running over to meet us and to take copies of our leaflets. Without doubt the Miliband effect was working wonders for our campaign!

Where we lost votes to UKIP, we gained votes in the Jewish communities in Kersal, Crumpsall and Broughton. I attended three hustings, in St Paul's Church, Kersal, the Red Bank Cafe, Cheetham and at Manchester University, in addition to being interviewed by Manchester Confidential and BBC World Service on video. The campaign saw us delivering leaflets and meeting voters every day over a four week period. In addition, I found time to help out in the target constituencies of Hazel Grove and Cheadle. Defeating Labour's Graham Stringer was always going tough but we gave it our best shot and got our message out.
